Lancashire Constabulary is committed to reducing the number of people killed and seriously injured on our roads and participates in the National Driver Offender Retraining Scheme.

You have **28 days** from the date of service of this notice to apply for the course which is an alternative to prosecution so you will not be fined for this offence and no penalty points will be applied to your licence if the course is completed.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - DIVERSIONARY COURSES

### Q. What is the criterion for being offered a diversionary course by Lancashire Constabulary?

There are a number of conditions which must be satisfied and these are noted below:

- You **must not** have completed a similar course for a previous offence which occurred within 3 years of this offence.
- You **must** book your course within 28 days following receipt of an offer by Lancashire Constabulary.
- For safety camera offences you **must** have admitted to being the driver within 4 months of the alleged offence.
- For all motorists, you **must** attend and successfully complete the course within 5 months of the date of your offence.

Please note Lancashire Constabulary retain the right to withdraw a course offer at any time up to the point that you have successfully completed the course. Please also bear in mind that if you book a course close to your 5 month deadline and do not attend, it will **not** be possible to rearrange another course.

### Q. Will I be required to produce a full valid driving licence on the day of the course?

The Service Provider will need to confirm your identity on the day of the course and a photo card driving licence is one of the easiest ways to do this; for the Driving 4 Change (D4C) course, a full driving licence including counterpart is required as your entitlement to drive must be checked.

### Q. What are the thresholds for being offered a Speed Awareness Course?

### Q. How do I book a course?

Only if you are eligible for a course will the required paperwork be enclosed and this explains what you need to do next. Please note if you choose to book a course Lancashire Constabulary will be notified by your course provider and there is no need to notify us separately.

### Q. I have applied for a course; do I still need to send my licence and £60 fine to you?

No. You only pay the course provider the relevant course fee; however, if you fail to complete the course the matter will be referred back to the Police.

### Q. I want to attend a course in Lancashire – what do I do next?

#### 1. On Line Application

If you have been offered Speed Awareness or RIDE you can book your course online – please visit the website below where you can search available dates, book and pay for your course:

This service allows you to choose a date which suits you best. Please note you must complete the course within 5 months of the date of your offence and you will therefore only be able to view courses up to this date.

#### 2. Postal Application

For “What’s Driving Us” and “Driving 4 Change” you **must** apply by completing the enclosed application form and returning it to the address on the application form together with your course fee (made payable to ‘Lancashire County Council’). At this time there is no facility to book online for either of these 2 courses however you can access the dates and times of the courses by visiting <https://dors.police.uk>

Although you can complete an online application for Speed Awareness and RIDE you may also complete the enclosed form if you would rather make a postal application.

Remember your postal application **must** be received by the Service Provider within 28 days of service of this letter.

**IMPORTANT: If you do not receive confirmation of a course date within 3 weeks of submitting a postal application please contact LCC Road & Transport Safety Group on (01772) 534487. Failure to do so may jeopardise your chance of being offered a course.**

### Q. I have the opportunity to complete a diversionary course but do not live in Lancashire, what alternative do I have?

If you want to attend a course closer to home **do not** complete the paper application form but using the enclosed Service Provider information sheet contact the appropriate provider directly; please note that course availability and fees vary.

### Q. Do I need to inform Lancashire Constabulary once I have completed my course?

No – on successful completion the force will be notified automatically and no further action will be taken regarding the offence.



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - CONDITIONAL OFFER OF FIXED PENALTY

### Q. I can't find my driving licence (and/or counterpart), what do I do now?

- You must submit both parts of your licence to comply with the conditional offer of a fixed penalty. If you have lost or misplaced either part you should apply for a new licence immediately; you can apply online at <http://www.direct.gov.uk> by clicking on the 'motoring' link or by obtaining a D1 form from a Post Office.
- You have 28 days from the date of service of the conditional offer to accept the fixed penalty, any delay in applying for a new licence may jeopardise your opportunity to resolve the matter via the conditional offer and you may be referred to Court instead.

\* If you have not received a new licence from DVLA within 14 days of submitting a request you should contact them immediately \*

### Q. Can I bring my licence and payment to you in person?

No. Lancashire Constabulary's Central Process Unit is not a publicly accessible building. If you are worried about your documents being lost in transit you should consider sending them by recorded delivery.

### Q. Can I pay the Conditional Offer by instalments?

No. Your payment must be for the full fixed penalty amount of £60; unfortunately there is no facility for paying by instalments.

Please note, underpayments will not be accepted and overpayments will lead to a delay in processing your fixed penalty acceptance which risks the matter being referred to the Magistrates' Court.

### Q. Can I have a higher fine and no penalty points?

No. If you receive a fixed penalty the fine is set by the government and is not negotiable; the current penalty is £60 and 3 points.

### Q. What happens if I want the Magistrates' Court to decide my fine?

If you are guilty of the offence the Magistrates' Court will consider your financial circumstances and that of the offence to determine the penalty amount you will be ordered to pay if convicted. For example, for a guilty plea entered at the first hearing the fine for a speeding offence will typically be £60, plus £50 prosecution costs and a £15 Victim Surcharge. If you are found guilty in your absence (where no plea is provided at the first hearing) the fine may increase and prosecution costs will rise to £85 plus the Victim Surcharge. If your case proceeds to trial and you are found guilty, the fine and costs may be considerably higher.

### Q. I already have points on my licence, what will happen to me next?

- If you have 9 or more penalty points on your licence within the last 3 years you may be liable for disqualification and the matter may be referred to the Magistrates' Court but you should still submit your payment and licence for consideration.
- If you have less than 9 penalty points within the last 3 years then HMCTS will be able to accept your licence and endorse it with 3 more points. It is your responsibility to ensure your employer and insurer is informed of any points where necessary.

### Q. I'm a new driver, will I lose my licence?

If you reach 6 or more penalty points within 2 years of passing your test the DVLA will automatically revoke your licence on being notified by the Fixed Penalty Office (HMCTS). In these circumstances HMCTS have a legal obligation to forward your licence to the DVLA in Swansea, if they make the decision to revoke your licence you will have to obtain a provisional licence and drive as a learner until you have retaken both the theory and practical tests to regain your full driving licence.

## DIVERSIONARY COURSES

### OFFERED BY LANCASHIRE CONSTABULARY AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO PROSECUTION

#### **National Speed Awareness Course (NSAC)**

This course was introduced to give motorists who drive in excess of the speed limit within agreed thresholds the opportunity to attend a workshop and is offered to motorists as an alternative to the fixed penalty of 3 points and £60 fine. Lancashire Constabulary's appointed Service Provider, Lancashire County Council, deliver NSAC on behalf of the force and this is currently a 4 hour interactive classroom based driver education package costing **£70**. The course covers why people speed, what difference speed makes, what could happen if you speed, how to recognise the speed limit, hazard perception and defensive driving strategies.

#### **What's Driving Us? (WDU)**

This national course is offered to motorists committing one of a variety of minor motoring offences (including using mobile phones while driving, not in position to have proper control of vehicle and going through red traffic lights). This course is targeted at those whose attitudes rather than skills mean they represent a danger to themselves and other road users because of the risks they take. Lancashire County Council deliver WDU which is a classroom based session lasting 3¼ hours and costing **£70**. The course aim is to produce safer and more responsible attitudes towards driving and to increase motivation to drive with consideration for other road users.

#### **Driving 4 Change (D4C)**

This national course is offered to motorists committing one of a variety of minor motoring offences (including failing to comply with a no entry or stop sign, driving on the hard shoulder of a motorway and overtaking or stopping within a pedestrian crossing) but is designed for those who demonstrate carelessness or under performance in their driving ability. Lancashire County Council deliver D4C which is a practical on-road session delivered by suitably qualified Approved Driving Instructors on a 2-1 ratio using dual controlled vehicles; the course lasts 2¼ hours and costs **£70**. The aim of the course is to raise an individuals' awareness of their driving skills deficits, increase understanding of what constitutes safer driving behaviour and improve driving skills.

#### **Rider Intervention Developing Experience (RIDE)**

RIDE was introduced for those who ride motorcycles in a careless or inconsiderate manner or whose riding behaviour is considered to be anti-social. Lancashire County Council deliver this course which is an interactive classroom session lasting 7 hours and costing **£95**. This course is designed as an intervention for those motorcyclists whose behaviour has brought them to the attention of the Police; it addresses the behaviour of those whose riding could be described as thrill or sensation seeking and those who by the very nature of their riding could be defined as anti-social or careless. It can also be used for motorcyclists who have demonstrated careless riding which has led to a collision.
