Now is the time for all households in the UK to register.

By law, you have to register every year.

Not registering can lead to a £1,000 fine. Giving false information can lead to a £5,000 fine.

- If you have registered in the last few months you still have to confirm your details
- If you are a citizen of one of the countries listed over the page - AND you live at this address - your name has to be on
- If you are not eligible to register, you have to tell us why in part 4.
- You can change your opt-out choice on the phone or internet but NOT by text.

Who has to register to vote?

Age: If you are an eligible person, you can register if you are aged 16 or over (16/17 year olds can vote from their 18th birthday)

Residence: You can only register for an address if you actually live there. You can register at a temporary address if you have no other home. Landlords cannot register for an address they own, unless they live there.

Nationality: Only British, qualifying Commonwealth, Irish and European Union citizens can register. "Qualifying" means Commonwealth citizens who have leave to enter or remain in the UK or

British, Commonwealth and Irish citizens can vote at all elections.

Not eligible to vote?

If you are not eligible to vote you must still return this

Important - If you are a citizen of a country NOT listed above you CANNOT vote - even if you are allowed to live in this country.

Jury service

People over 70 are not called for jury service. People who cannot serve for other reasons can say so if they get a jury summons.

Second homes

People who live at two homes are allowed to register at both, but can only vote once at the same election. For more advice ring the helpline.

Anonymous registration

If your personal safety would be at risk from your name appearing in the Voters List, you may be able to register anonymously.

Special rules for certain electors

There are special rules to make registration and voting easier for:

- people living or working overseas
- remand prisoners
- homeless people
- mental health patients in care

They must NOT be included on your form. Please ring the helpline for more details. Members of HM forces can now register on this form, if they live at your address.

Registering by phone in other languages

To register by phone in another language, please **freephone 0800 107 4426** and when prompted, press (1) for Albanian (2) for Arabic (3) for Farsi (4) for French (5) for Italian (6) for Polish (7) for Portuguese (8) for Somali or (9) for Spanish.

The two versions of the voters list - "opt out" explained

The electoral registration officer makes and keeps two versions of the voters list - a full version and an edited version.

The full voters list

The full voters list lists the name and address of everyone who is registered to vote. The council holds a copy. Anyone can look at it, but it is a criminal offence to supply or use copies for purposes other than those set down in law. More information is available at www.aboutmyvote.co.uk

The main use of the full register is to show who can vote in elections and referendums. Credit reference agencies can use it, but only to check your name and address if you are applying for

credit and for other purposes specified in law. It can also be used for law enforcement.

The edited voters list

The edited list is available for general sale and can be used for any purpose. The edited register can be bought by any person, company or organisation and be used for commercial activities such as marketing.

If you do not want your details sold from the edited list, you must tell us. Either tick the 'opt out' box, or if you register by phone or online, please follow the instructions given. Please ask other household members if they want to be on the edited list or not. If you have already 'opted out', this is shown over the page. You can change this, if you wish.
