DECREE *NISI* OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

IN THE FEDERAL MAGISTRATES COURT OF AUSTRALIA

BEFORE THE FEDERAL MAGISTRATES COURT OF AUSTRALIA

The eighteenth day of June 2002.

1. The application of JACQUELINE DAWN LISEWSKI for dissolution of the marriage of the abovenamed husband and wife was heard this day.
2. The court was satisfied that the abovenamed JACQUELINE DAWN LISEWSKI was domiciled in Australia.
3. The court held that the marriage had broken down irretrievably.
4. The court decreed that, upon and subject to the decree of the court becoming absolute, the marriage solemnised at ST LUCIA QUEENSLAND on the twenty-sixth day of October 1991, between the abovenamed husband and wife be dissolved.
5. The court by order declared that it was satisfied that the only child/children of the marriage who have not attained the age of 18 years is/are the child/children specified in the order and proper arrangements in all the circumstances have been made for the care, welfare and development of the child/children.
